1. INFO ABOUT ISRAK and MIKRAJ (24 April 2017)

Israk and Mikraj is observed on the 27th day of the month of Rejab, the seventh month in the Islamic calendar. This event marks the night that Allah took Prophet Muhammad PBUH on a miraculous journey from Makkah to Jerusalem (Israk) and then to Heaven (Mikraj). According to the Quran and Hadith, Prophet Muhammad PBUH rode to heaven on a winged steed known as a Buraq. Prophet Muhammad PBUH was shown heaven and hell. He talked with many prophets, including Prophet Isa and Prophet Musa, in heaven. He also received instructions from Allah on our obligatory daily prayers (Solat). Some Islamic scholars regard Prophet Muhammad's miraculous journey as a spiritual experience while others see it as a physical journey.
